

CANTON REPOSITORY STARK COUNTY ALL-DECADE BASEBALL TEAM

■ Tyler Adams, Louisville, INF, 2017

NBC Player of the Year as a senior when he batted .412 with four triples, 35 stolen bases and 39 runs scored. Led the Leopards to a league championship. ... Two-time All-NBC first team. ... Batted .352 as a junior with six doubles, three triples and two HRs. ... Career .386 hitter with a school-record 66 stolen bases. ... Playing football for Harvard.

■ Brock Begue, Marlinton, INF-P, 2017

Went 10-0 with a 0.56 ERA in 2016 to gain NBC Player of the Year. Also batted .294 with 15 RBIs. ... Overcame ACL injury his senior year to earn first team All-NBC again. ... Pitched two seasons at Cuyahoga Community College, going 10-1 with a 1.61 ERA in 2018 and 11-1 with a 2.07 ERA in 2019. ... Selected in 11th round by Milwaukee Brewers in 2019 MLB Draft.

■ Ryan Bergert, GlenOak, INF-P, 2018

Went 4-1 with a 3.19 ERA and struck out 66 batters in 37.1 IP in 2018. Also led GlenOak with 18 RBIs. ... Hit .357 as a junior and .347 as a sophomore. ... Already has earned several athletic and academic honors in two seasons for West Virginia, including the All-Big 12 Tournament Team as a freshman. ... Was 2-1 with a 2.92 ERA through four starts in 2020.

■ Logan Bowles, Canton South/McKinley, INF-P, 2012

First team All-Ohio and NBC Player of the Year in 2012. Went 10-2 with a 1.05 ERA. Batted .370 with 18 RBIs. ... Four-year varsity starter who played freshman year at McKinley, then final three years at South. Earned some level of all-league recognition all four years. ... Ohio State recruit who finished collegiate career at Walsh.

■ Nate Cobb, Jackson, OF, 2016

Repository Stark County Player of the Year and Federal League Player of the Year as a senior when he batted .427 with five triples, 11 stolen bases and 32 runs scored. First team All-Ohio. ... Tremendous defensive center fielder. ... Leadoff hitter for Jackson team that won first 29 games of 2016 season before losing in a regional semifinal. ... Batted .385 as a junior with 30 runs. ... Career at Malone has been highlighted by being the 2017 G-MAC Freshman of the Year after hitting .352.

■ JC Colangelo, Central Catholic, OF, 2016

Starter on 2015 state championship team and 2016 regional semifinalist. ... Second team All-Ohio as a senior. Batted .447 with 14 stolen bases while not committing an error in CF. ... Batted .303 with 18 steals and 26 runs as a junior. ... On same day, finished second in the 100 meters at state track meet before going 2-for-3 with a run in Central baseball's 2015 state championship game win against Cincinnati Summit Country Day. ... Ran sprints at Princeton.

■ Zach Dezenzo, Marlinton, INF-P, 2018

NBC Player of the Year in 2018. Batted .522 with 11 doubles, three triples, a HR, 31 RBIs, 34 runs scored and 16 stolen bases. ... Four-year letterman for the Dukes. ... Two-time Repository All-Stark County first team. ... Batted .420 as a junior. ... Ohio State recruit who was named to Freshman All-American Team after hitting 10 HRs last season.

■ Danny DiGiambatista, St. Thomas Aquinas, INF-P, 2015

Four-year varsity letterman and two-time first team All-North Coast League selection. ... Led Knights to consecutive league and district championships. ... Set school records for single-season hits (44), runs (35), walks (25) and pitching wins (7) as a senior when he earned honorable mention All-Ohio. Batted .431 with 14 steals while going 7-1 with a 2.70 ERA. ... Graduated with Aquinas career records in ABs (293), runs (86) and walks (75). ... Injury prevented him from playing at John Carroll.

■ Dillon Dingler, Jackson, C, 2017

Three-year starter who was second team All-Ohio and Co-Federal League Player of the Year as a senior when he batted .462 with 30 RBIs and 13 steals. ... Helped lead Jackson to 2017 Division I state championship as well as three straight Federal League and district titles. ... Batted .358 with 10 doubles, 23 RBIs and 12 steals as a junior. ... Three-year starter at Ohio State, where he earned third team All-America this past season. ... Selected 37th overall by the Detroit Tigers in last month's MLB Draft, becoming second highest Stark County pick in draft history.

■ Alex Grove, Central Catholic, C, 2011

Starter at catcher for three straight district championship teams and 2011 state championship team. ... Switch hitter batted .343 with six doubles and 26 RBIs as a senior, striking out twice in 105 ABs. ... Drove in 25 runs as a junior. ... Four-year starter at Heidelberg and three-time All-OAC honoree, including first team as a junior when he batted .324 and drove in 37 runs.

■ Will Haueter, Hoover, C, 2014

Hoover's all-time leader in RBIs and runs. ... Federal League Player of the Year in 2014 when he batted .419 with 13 doubles and 17 RBIs. ... Two-time first team All-Federal League. ... Batted .422 with 11 doubles, two triples, a HR and 29 RBIs in 2013. ... Batted .322 with nine doubles, two triples, a HR and 36 RBIs (which tied for Stark County lead) as a sophomore. ... In college, a career .323 hitter whose 58 doubles tie for all-time mark at Northern Kentucky. Earned various athletic and academic honors for the Norse, including first team All-Horizon League as a junior when he batted .360.

■ Dom Iero, Hoover, INF, 2013

Hoover's all-time hits and doubles leader. ... Federal League Player of the Year and honorable mention All-Ohio in 2013. ... Two-time first team All-Federal League. ... Batted .421 with 13 doubles, two triples, two HRs and 30 RBIs in 2013. ... Batted .431 with 13 doubles, a triple and 22 RBIs in 2012. ... Akron recruit who finished career at Kent State after Zips dropped baseball. Named to All-MAC

Defensive Team in 2017. ... Played two seasons in the Frontier League.

■ Aidan Longwell, Massillon, INF-P, 2020

Lefty went 5-0 with a 0.43 ERA as a sophomore in 2018. Registered 32 straight scoreless innings. Also led Massillon in batting average (.398), doubles (7), triples (2) and RBIs (23). ... Batted a team-best .405 with nine doubles and 15 RBIs as a freshman. ... Lost junior season to shoulder injury and senior season to COVID-19. ... Kent State recruit.

■ Chris Machamer, Massillon, P, 2016

Gatorade Ohio Player of the Year, Northeast District Pitcher of the Year and first team All-Ohio in 2016 when he batted .523 and slugged .908 with nine doubles, five triples, two HRs, 26 RBIs and 30 runs. Went 5-1 with 0.19 ERA in seven appearances with 60 Ks in 36.1 innings. ... Kentucky recruit who went 4-1 with 11 saves and a 3.12 ERA in 47 career appearances for the Wildcats. ... Drafted in 16th round by Boston Red Sox in 2018.

■ Jake Miller, Jackson, OF, 2014

Four-year varsity starter who graduated as Jackson's all-time hits leader. ... Batted .389 with team highs of 29 RBIs, 11 doubles, three triples and 16 stolen bases for 2014 Polar Bears, who won the Division I state championship. ... Attended IMG Academy for one year before playing at Northern Kentucky.

■ Tommy Monnot, GlenOak, C, 2011

Batted .384 with seven doubles, three HRs and 35 RBIs as a junior, leading GlenOak to a district championship. First team All-Federal League. ... Batted .295 with two HRs and 26 RBIs his senior year as GlenOak returned to the district final and won a share of a second straight league title. ... Batted over .400 as a sophomore. ... Four-year letterman at Kent State, where he batted .244 with six HRs, 15 doubles and 23 RBIs as a senior.

■ Kyle Mottice, Jackson, INF, 2014

Catalyst for Jackson's 2014 state championship team, batting .488 with 32 runs out of the leadoff spot. ... Terrific middle infielder defensively. ... Played collegiately at Cincinnati, where he batted .335 with 45 runs and 20 steals as a senior leadoff hitter. ... Signed a free-agent deal with Pittsburgh Pirates after going undrafted in 2018. Batted .316 in 53 games for Class A Greensboro last year.

■ Patrick Murphy, Central Catholic, OF-P, 2015

Second team All-Ohio and Division III-IV Northeast District Player of the Year as a senior when he went 9-1 with a 0.90 ERA and struck out 90 batters in 62 innings. Also drove in 20 runs and drew 31 walks. ... Led Central to 2015 state championship, earning the win in the semifinal and the save in the final. ... Batted .446 and went 7-1 with a 0.92 ERA in 2014. ... Marshall recruit. Went 4-3 with a 1.67 ERA as a freshman in 2016. Went 2-1 with a 2.95 ERA out of the bullpen in 2019 after working back from injury. ... Pitched for Ohio

State in 2020 as a grad transfer.

■ Kyle Nicolas, Jackson, INF-P, 2017

Repository Stark County Player of the Year and Northeast District Player of the Year as a senior when he went 8-0 with a 0.50 ERA. Batted .349 with 24 RBIs. ... Co-Federal League Player of the Year and first team All-Ohio. ... Helped lead Jackson to 2017 state championship. ... Three-year letterman for Ball State who — after a 17-strikeout performance for the Cardinals — was drafted 61st overall by the Miami Marlins last month.

■ Yianni Skeriotis, Jackson, P, 2019

Won first 28 decisions of career — including 2017 Division I state title game — before losing 1-0 in a regional semifinal as a senior. The 28 straight wins are the third longest streak in state history. ... 2019 Ohio Division I Player of the Year. ... Two-time Repository Stark County and Federal League Player of the Year. ... Two-time first team All-Ohio. ... Went 10-1 with a 0.12 ERA as a senior. ... Career 0.88 ERA with two no-hitters. Went 17-0 in league play. ... Ohio State recruit.

■ Joe Tann, Central Catholic, INF-P, 2011

Set Central single-season records in wins and strikeouts when he went 11-3 with a 1.14 ERA as a senior. Totaled 10 complete games in 16 appearances. Struck out 136 batters in 86 innings. Also batted .393 with 24 RBIs. ... Earned the win in all four of Central's regional and state games en route to the 2011 championship. Threw 140 pitches in a complete-game state semifinal win, then came back two days later to throw 59 more in the final. ... Honorable mention All-Ohio. ... Walsh recruit who went 2-1 with a 3.56 ERA as a senior in 2015.

■ Kyle Tisdale, Lake, C, 2011

Federal League Player of the Year in 2011, helping Blue Streaks to a share of their last league title. ... Batted .463 with five HRs and 25 RBIs. ... Career .317 hitter as a four-year starter for Ohio Dominican. Two-time first team All-GLIAC selection while also garnering numerous academic honors.

■ Jake Vance, Central Catholic, INF-P, 2016

Four-year varsity letterman who is tied for the most career wins (25) in Central history despite missing part of senior season because of suspension. One of those wins was the 2015 state championship game. ... Went 8-1 with a 1.34 ERA and 86 strikeouts in 68 innings as a junior. ... Went 8-2 with a 1.36 ERA and 75 strikeouts in 2014. ... Ohio State recruit who has gone 6-8 with a 5.60 ERA in 38 career appearances and earned Academic All-Big Ten twice.

■ DJ Wilson, Canton South, OF-P, 2015

Ohio Division II Player of the Year in 2015. ... Three-time first team All-Ohio pick, four-year varsity starter. ... Led South to four straight district titles and three straight NBC championships. ... Batted .545 with four HRs, eight triples, 17 doubles, 30 RBIs, 30 steals and 40 runs as a senior. ... Batted .506 with 29 RBIs, 34 runs, two HRs and 22 SBs in 2014. ... Batted .483 with four doubles, nine triples, 25 RBIs and 15 stolen bases in 2013. ... Batted .427 with three HRs and 28 RBIs as a freshman. ... Vanderbilt recruit who was picked in fourth round by Chicago Cubs in 2015 MLB Draft.

■ Trey Wright, Jackson, C-INF, 2019

Tied for most hits in Jackson history. Struck out nine times in 324 career plate appearances. ... First team All-Ohio catcher as a senior when he batted .467 with 15 RBIs and 14 steals. ... Honorable Mention All-Ohio as a junior when he batted .458 with 16 RBIs and 13 steals. ... Starter at second base for 2017 state championship team. Batted .364 with 17 RBIs. ... Career .434 hitter, including .421 with runners in scoring position. ... Starting catcher at Toledo as a freshman.
